September 14, 1942

Just having rescued 13 crew and 5 gunners from the Tanker "Empire Oil" the HMCS Ottawa was attacked by the German Submarine U-91. Two torpedoes were aimed at the ship but only one struck amidships and the destroyer blew up and sank immediately.

With the loss of 106 crew and the 18 shipwrecked men rescued earlier

We must never forget their sacrifice

.....

From the war diary of Joseph Ambrose Walter Lees:

"The Ottawa got it on the 13th, there were only 69 survivors out of a crew of 175, plus 50 that they had picked out of the water. She was hit in the mess deck and in the boiler room. She broke in two. The halves stood on end and went straight down"

Easy Sunshine Salad

INGREDIENTS:

1 fresh pineapple, cored and cut into chunks
1 can (15 oz) of Mandarin oranges in light syrup
2 bananas, peeled and sliced
1 box (4 serving size) Jello Vanilla Instant Pudding
Mini Marshmallows

INSTRUCTIONS:

Keep the Mandarin oranges in their syrup; do not drain.

Chop the pineapple and bananas into chunks.

In a large bowl, combine all the fruit.

Evenly sprinkle the dry vanilla pudding mix over the fruit (do not mix with milk). Stir the mixture thoroughly.

Cover and refrigerate for at least one hour before serving.

Fold mini marshmallows in before serving.

Each serving is approximately one cup.
