## HMCS Regina



On August 8, 1944,

The American merchant [ship](#) Ezra Weston was hit by one torpedo. The HMCS Regina turned and slowed down to pick up survivors, thinking that the merchant ship had been mined. The U-boat fired a Gnat at the HMCS Regina, which blew up and sank within 30 seconds. A British-armed trawler picked up the commander and 65 crew members.

30 of the ship's crew were killed.

*We must never forget their sacrifice*

### U-Boat

**U-boat** is a “made into English” version of the German word ***U-Boot*** [ˈuːboːt], a shortening of the word ‘***Unterseeboot***’, literally meaning “undersea boat.”, the German term refers to any submarine.

The primary targets of the U-boat campaigns in both wars were the merchant convoys bringing supplies from Canada and other parts of the British Empire, and from the United States to the United Kingdom and (during the Second World War) to the Soviet Union and the Allied territories in the Mediterranean. German submarines also destroyed Brazilian merchant ships during World War II, causing Brazil to declare war on the Axis powers in 1944.

# Salmon Cakes



1 can salmon, drained and flaked  
1 small onion, minced  
1tbsp Worcestershire sauce  
1/4 tsp ground black pepper  
2Tbsp chopped parsley, fresh  
1/4 cup butter

1 egg  
1/2cup bread crumbs  
1/8 hot pepper sauce  
1/4 cup shredded Cheddar cheese  
2 tbsp all-purpose flour for coating  
3 tbsp olive oil

Combine salmon, onion, egg, breadcrumbs, Worcestershire sauce, hot pepper sauce, black pepper, cheese, and parsley....mix well  
Shape into 4 patties. Dust lightly with flour. Chill for 20-30 minutes.  
In a large skillet, heat butter and olive oil over medium-high heat. Cook the patties until golden brown on both sides approx.. 10minutes. Drain briefly on paper towels before serving with your favourite sauce.

## Creamy Dill Sauce

1/4 c light sour cream  
1 tsp dill weed  
1/4 tsp garlic powder  
sea salt to taste  
Mix all together in a bowl, and serve alongside salmon patties.



## Lemon Yogurt Sauce

3/4 cup plain yogurt  
1 tsp lemon juice  
1/4 tsp salt  
chopped chives  
Lemon zest  
Mix all together in a bowl, serve alongside salmon patties.

## Chili mayonnaise

1/2 cup mayonnaise  
1/2 chili sauce  
2 tbsp relish  
Mix all together in a bowl, serve alongside salmon patties.



## Creamy Garlic Sauce

1/4 c mayonnaise  
1-2 garlic cloves- pressed  
1 tbsp lemon juice  
salt to taste  
Heavy cream (tbsp at a time to thin it to a pourable consistency).  
Cover and set aside for 30 minutes or longer in the refrigerator. Drizzle over salmon patties.

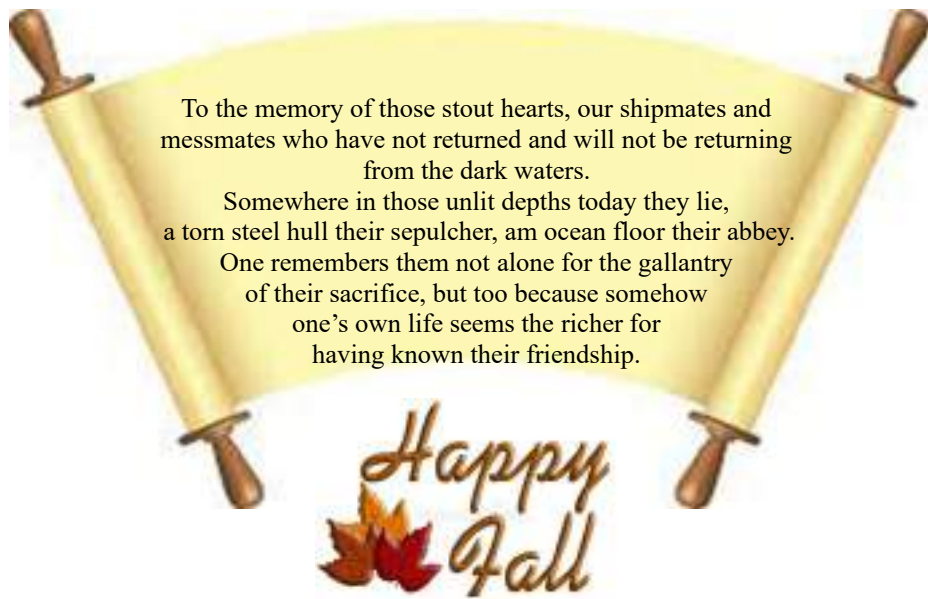

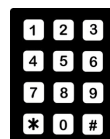
